

## **INSY Thesis and Dissertation Guidelines**

Starting Fall Semester 2009, the Graduate School no longer requires that students submit paper copies of theses and dissertations; however, the Industrial and Systems Engineering department requires a bound, hard-copy to be submitted for our internal library. Students will need to use a commercial binder, such as CopyCat in order to produce the hard-copy.
