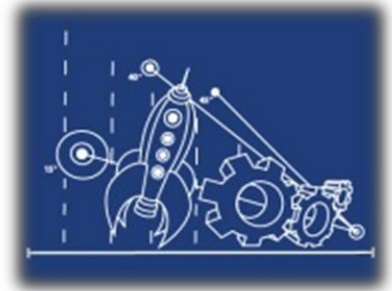

### HELPFUL INFORMATION TO KNOW

#### Transfer Admission Minimum GPA – 2.5

- 1) To meet core requirements and student learning outcomes, it is recommended to take a **world history sequence** (US History does not meet this requirement)
- 2) There is very little room for electives in all of the COE academic programs; therefore, transferring with all core requirements completed can make your first semester difficult. Be prepared and seek help through tutoring and academic support.
- 3) Even though courses may have AU equivalents, they still may not fit the degree program you are seeking, check the curriculum sheets to be sure.
- 4) You must have a **2.2 AUBURN GPA** to move into major; therefore, your first semester at Auburn is **EXTREMELY** important to your success!
