

DUAL MBA AND MISE

The Department of Industrial and Systems Engineering offers a dual Master of Industrial and Systems Engineering (MISE)/Master of Business Administration (MBA.) This option is offered to students with undergraduate degrees in industrial engineering, other engineering disciplines, mathematics or sciences from an institution of recognized standing. Applicants must apply separately to each program and should contact the Graduate School when applying to the second program to receive an application fee waiver. The GRE or GMAT may be waived for students applying to the ISE program who have an engineering degree from an ABET-accredited institution and have a 2.75-plus GPA. However, students applying for the MBA should check with the MBA department regarding whether they should take the GRE or GMAT.

Degree Requirements (55 total credit hours)

- MISE:
 - » 28 hours of INSY courses including:
 - ◇ Manufacturing/Production Economics
 - ◇ Advanced Engineering Statistics I
 - ◇ Linear Programming and Network Flows
 - ◇ Seminar
 - ◇ 18 hours of electives including:
 - 12 hours of INSY electives
 - 6 additional hours of INSY or ISE-related elective hours
- MBA:
 - » 27 hours of BUSI courses including:
 - ◇ 24 hours of BUSI required (core) courses
 - ◇ 3 hours (one course) of MBA electives
- There are no residency, foreign language or minor requirements.
