

MASTER OF ENGINEERING

The Master of Engineering offers an on-campus or completely online degree tailored to fit the specific needs of each student. Each student will design a plan of study which is submitted with the application and is reviewed and approved by the relevant departments. Student may complete courses in any of the following engineering disciplines:

- Aerospace
- Chemical
- Civil
- Computer Science and Software
- Electrical and Computer
- Industrial and Systems
- Materials
- Mechanical

The plan must identify multiple areas of concentration within each selected department. Each area should be supported by several courses in the plan of study. There is no GRE or thesis requirement and graduate certificates from the above disciplines may be combined to design a student's degree.

Degree Requirements:

- 30 credit hours of graduate-level coursework
 - » 21 hours must be at the 6000-level and above
 - » 9 elective hours
