

T-Shirt Design

Overview

This competition allows for showing the school's artistic ability, creativity and student involvement while incorporating the following T-shirt design guidelines. Traditionally, the T-shirts will be worn on the day of the canoe races.

Objective

The T-shirt should symbolize the competition's theme and incorporate your school heritage.

Eligibility

Each school may enter one (1) design for the T-shirt competition. The number of students that may contribute is unlimited; however, the team captain must be an undergraduate student.

Logistics

T-shirt design will be presented and evaluated by a panel of three (3) judges.

Submittals

Each team submits one (1) t-shirt design. The time the submittals are due will be on the official conference schedule.

Materials

The submittal must meet all requirements. No additional materials are required.

Execution

7.1 All questions regarding the competition rules may be directed towards the event coordinator.

7.2 T-shirts must be 100% cotton and baseball style shirts (sleeves of a different color than the body). Refer to the picture to the right.

7.3 T-shirt sleeves must be three-quarter or full length.



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7.4 The sleeves and body may be any color, but the body must be a different color than the sleeves.

7.5 T-shirts may be painted, appliqué, or screen-printed (back, front, or both) and may use as many colors as desired; however, no embroidery is allowed.

7.6 The name of your school and theme must be prominently displayed on the design.

Judging

Three judges will collectively rank the t-shirt designs based on the following areas:

- Display of theme and school name
- Originality
- Artistic Quality and Aesthetics
- Relevance to the theme and Civil Engineering

Scoring

1 st	15 points
2 nd	12 points
3 rd	10 points
4 th	7 points
5 th	5 points
All others	3 points

Disqualifications

Teams may be disqualified if they fail to meet all of the rules and/or eligibility rules. Disqualifications will be determined at the discretion of the judges.
