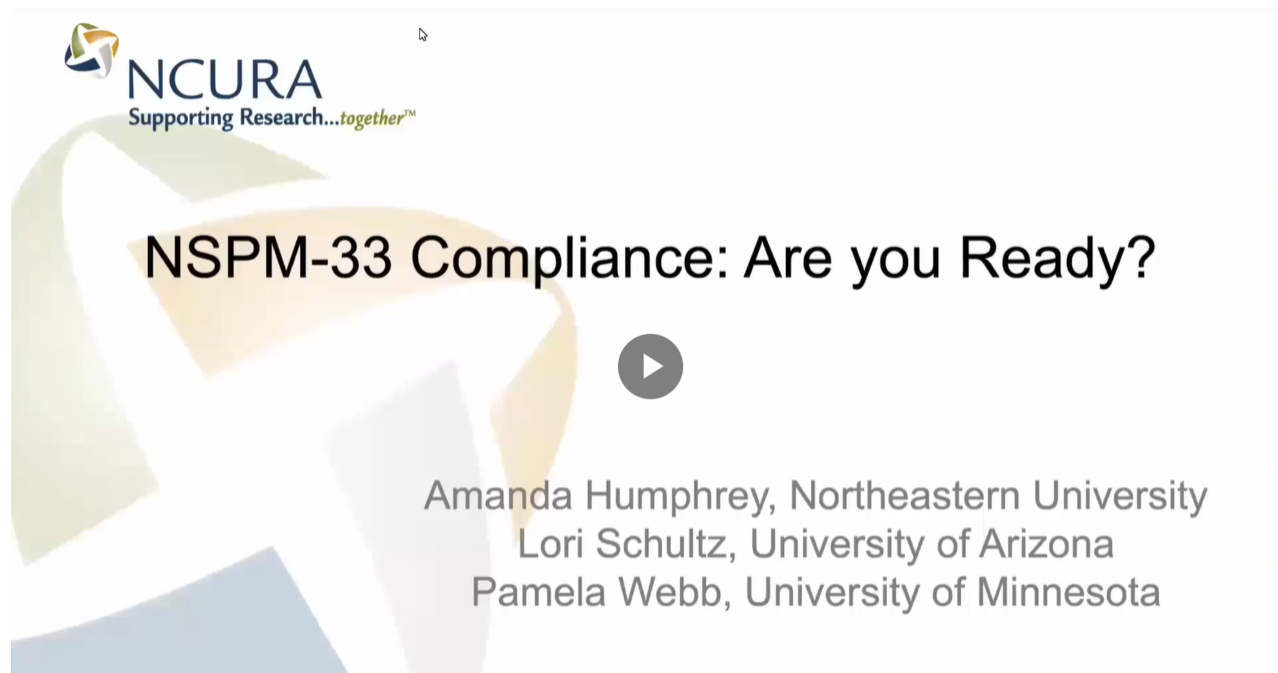

Next Era of Wireless and Spectrum (NewSpectrum)

National Science Foundation

Due May 28, 2024

Areas of interest: electrical, electronics, and computer engineering

This call seeks to proposals which will improve fundamental understanding of the electromagnetic spectrum. Existing approaches have struggled with increasing demands for spectrum powered by continuous advances in wireless technologies in new scientific, military, and commercial applications.

Research initiatives that will enable the US to smoothly and quickly transition to effective new ways of using and managing the radio and optical spectrum are encouraged. There are no limitations on this proposal, and an individual may be listed as PI or Co-PI on no more than 2 proposals.
