

Application for Assistance through the Safety Technical Assistance Program for Alabama Cities and Counties (STACC)



The Safety Technical Assistance Program for Alabama Cities and Counties (STACC) is funded by the Federal Highway Administration through the Alabama Department of Transportation. The mission of the program is to provide road safety technical assistance to Alabama's cities and counties, particularly those in rural areas or with relatively small populations.

This application is the mechanism by which local governments can request technical assistance to address highway safety concerns at specific locations or corridors on locally maintained roadways in their jurisdictions or to request related training. STACC assistance can include, but is not limited to, network screening, diagnosing safety problems, recommending countermeasures, and supporting road safety reviews. Please allow two weeks for a response regarding whether the request will be supported through STACC.

Site description (note key roadways, intersections, termini, etc.):

County Road 650 between the intersections of State Highway 333 and County Road 69

Description of safety issue or concern and summary of supporting information:

This 2.3 mile section carries 900 vehicles per day and had 15 crashes during the 5-year period of 2012-2016, resulting in a crash rate over twice the statewide average. 10 of the 15 crashes are roadway departures in the same area. The severity distribution is 2 fatal, 6 injury and 7 PDO.

Description of requested STACC service:

Field review, detailed crash analysis, and identification of low-cost as well as ideal countermeasures.
