




- Birmingham Northern Beltline Feasibility Study began in 1989






## **BNB History**

- Added to ADHS and included in 2007 Cost Estimate








## FY20-26 ADHS Funding Appropriated as of 1-20-24 (in Millions)




# Construct and Open to Traffic from US-31 to SR-75







#### Striping Across Bridges in Interim Phase




