

KENYON FELLOWSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

National Center for Asphalt Technology

Applicants/recipients must:

- Be accepted by the Auburn University Graduate School and the Pavements & Materials graduate faculty.
- Complete the Kenyon Fellowship application form.
- Visit Auburn University and NCAT to meet with the NCAT Director and other researchers.
- Pursue research topics related to asphalt technology at Auburn University.
- Agree to serve as an ambassador for the asphalt paving industry as well as NCAT and Auburn University.
- Maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA and receive a positive recommendation at the beginning of each semester from their advisor.

Fellowship amounts and terms are determined by the NCAT Director. Kenyon Fellowships may only be given to students who are currently "in residence" at Auburn University. If a student has not completed his/her degree and leaves Auburn to begin another job, the fellowship will not be continued. Distance-learning/online students are not eligible for the Kenyon Fellowship.

- MSCE students may receive the Kenyon fellowship for a maximum of 6 semesters.
- PhD students may receive the Kenyon fellowship for a maximum of 9 semesters.
- Students who earn an MSCE degree and continue on to work on their PhD will be eligible to receive a Kenyon fellowship for a maximum of 15 semesters.

Applications will be accepted at any time. Completed applications should be submitted to the NCAT Director.
